This waiver covers all ice bookings under Chestermere Skating Club, at the Chestermere Community Recreation Centre, City of Calgary arenas, COP (WinSport), or any other arena booked for the purpose of adult skating.

It is understood and agreed that the Chestermere Skating Club/Skate Canada shall not be liable for injury or loss by a member while traveling to or participating in any activity by the club. The Chestermere Skating Club/Skate Canada shall not be responsible for loss or damage to a member. The member/member's parents/legal guardians agree to indemnify the Chestermere Skating Club/Skate Canada, Chestermere Regional Community Association/ City of Calgary arenas/COP (WinSport), or any other arena booked for the purpose of adult skating hold it harmless from any claims.

All members, parents and or legal guardians agree:

- To abide by the Chestermere Skating Club/Skate Canada, Chestermere Regional Community Association, City of Calgary arenas, COP (WinSport), or any other arena booked for the purpose of adult skating rules and regulations.
- Must have an active and current Skate Canada number
- That on occasion the Chestermere Skating Club has the right to cancel, restrict or limit registrations.
- The Chestermere Skating Club ice times and sessions are subject to change.
- Represent the Chestermere Skating Club in a respectful and professional manner.
- To strive to create and maintain cooperative relationships with fellow and coaching colleagues for the purpose of ensuring a positive skating environment.
- All skaters are to display good sportsmanship and encourage all skaters' enjoyment of skating.
- All skaters are responsible for keeping the dressing rooms clean and tidy. The skaters are responsible for putting away their own personal items and throwing away any garbage. Non-compliance will result in user fines.
- Please respect the use of the men's and women's dressing rooms for privacy. Please use the dressing room that has been assigned for your gender.

ICE ETIQUETTE

- iPod use is discouraged but is allowed if the skater uses one earphone for safety reasons.
- Soloist has the right of way but all skaters need to be aware of their surroundings and respect everyone on the ice.
- More experienced skaters will yield to the less experienced skaters for everyone's safety.
- Dancers must yield to free skaters unless it's a specified dance session.
- Coaches doing choreography also have the right of way if they are using music.
- When skating away from the boards, pay attention to oncoming skaters.
- Profanity or disrespect to fellow skaters or coaches will not be tolerated.
- Respect the use of the stereo by restricting multiple repeats of a solo and being mindful of others waiting and by returning the background music after solo is finished.
